Why this exists *(reproduced in full)*

The single most common way a foreign exporter loses money in Africa is not fraud in the dramatic sense. It is shipping to a company that is smaller, newer or less solvent than it appeared from a website and a confident email exchange.

No database resolves that. A registration search tells you a company was formed. A credit file, where one exists, tells you what was filed. Neither tells you whether there is a warehouse, whether there is stock in it, or whether the operation is one person with a laptop and a rented address.
